#### **INTRODUCTION**

1. Information contained in this document is for reference of candidates who are desirous of applying for selection as "Agniveervayu Non-Combatant" in intake 01/2025, under Agnipath scheme. Detailed information on eligibility criteria, job profile, procedure to apply, terms & conditions of service and sequence of examination is provided under respective sections in this Brochure. Candidates are required to thoroughly familiarize themselves with the information contained in this Brochure, prior to filling application form for selection as Agniveervayu Non-Combatants. Blank application and other required forms, together with detailed instructions on how to fill the application form, are available in sub-tab "Application "Agniveervayu Non-Combatants" Forms". under tab hosted on web portal https://agnipathvayu.cdac.in.

### **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

### 2. **Age.**

- (a) <u>Date of Birth Block</u>. Candidate born between **02 Jan 2004** and **02 Jul 2007** (both days inclusive) are eligible to apply.
- (b) In case, a candidate clears all the stages of the Selection Procedure, then the upper age limit as on date of enrolment should be 21 years.
- 3. Marital Status. Only unmarried male candidates will be eligible for enrolment as Agniveervayu Non-Combatant and they shall undertake not to marry during the defined engagement period of four years. Keeping in view limited period of engagement of Agniveervayu Non-Combatant inclusive of training, skill development activities, practical as well as formative assessment and organisational requirement of continued service of Agniveervayu Non-Combatant during the engagement period, longer absence of Agniveervayu Non-Combatant during the engagement period will adversely affect the operational efficiency of the Indian Air Force. Agniveervayu Non-Combatant who marry during the said period shall be discharged from the service. Further, only unmarried Agniveervayu Non-Combatant will be eligible for selection in regular cadre as NCs(E). At the time of enrolment, candidates shall require to sign a voluntary undertaking accepting above conditions.

- 4. <u>Educational Qualification</u>. Candidates should have passed **Matriculation / Equivalent examination** from "Education Boards recognized by Central, State and UT as on date of registration shall only be considered".
- 5. <u>Mandatory Medical Standards</u>. General Medical Standards for Agniveervayu Non-Combatant are as follows: -
  - (a) **Height:** Minimum acceptable height is **152 cms.**
  - (b) **Chest:** Minimum range of expansion: 5 cm
  - (c) **Weight:** Proportionate to height and age.
  - (d) Vision requirements as applicable as per Indian Air Force standards.
  - (e) **Hearing:** Candidate should have normal hearing i.e. able to hear forced whisper from a distance of 6 meters with each ear separately.
  - (f) **Dental:** Should have healthy gums, good set of teeth and minimum 14 dental points.
  - (g) **General Health:** Candidate should be of normal anatomy without loss or deformity of any appendages. He should be free from any active or latent, acute or chronic, medical or surgical disability or infection and skin ailments. Candidate shall be physically and mentally FIT to perform duty in any part of the world, in any climate and terrain.

#### 6. **General Disqualifications**.

- (a) <u>Consumption of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substance (NDPS).</u>
  Consumption of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic substances banned under the NDPS Act 1985 shall be rejection criteria for selection into the IAF and Agniveervayu Non-Combatant found either in possession or storing or distributing or consuming such drugs and substances after enrolment shall be liable for disciplinary action including dismissal from the IAF. ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY TO ALCOHOLISM AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE IS FOLLOWED IN IAF.
- (b) <u>Body Tattoo</u>. Permanent body tattoos shall not be permitted, however, tattoos only on inner face of the fore arms (inside of elbow to the wrist), back (dorsal) part of the hand/reverse side of palm and for Tribal tattoos which are as per custom and traditions of their tribes may be considered. However, right to decide whether the tattoo on the candidate is acceptable or not shall rest with the Selection Centre. Candidates with permanent body tattoos shall submit two photographs (close up and distant view) with details of size and type of the Tattoo, during the second phase of Selection Test.
- 7. **Only Sikh Candidates**, whose religion prohibits cutting of the hair or shaving of face, shall be permitted to grow hair and/or retain beard and moustache. Accordingly, those Sikh candidates willing to retain the same as per laid down specification are to get their photographs with beard and moustache.

#### JOB PROFILE

- 8. Candidates selected as "Agniveervayu Non-Combatant" will, in addition to specific duties assigned to them in organisational interest, be required to perform various duties and tasks, as assigned from time to time, under Hospitality or Housekeeping Streams. The job profile under respective streams are as follows: -
  - (a) <u>Hospitality Stream</u>. In this stream, an individual is expected to perform all jobs / task associated with cooking, kitchen management, presentation of dishes, maintain sanitized and orderly environment in the kitchen, safe storage of food and other items, handling of crockery, cutlery, refrigeration etc., laying of tables / chairs and serving of food, water etc.
  - (b) <u>Housekeeping Stream</u>. In this stream, an individual is expected to perform all jobs / task associated with cleaning of floors / roads / rooms / bathroom / commodes / urinals etc., making of brooms, grass / hedge cutting, ground leveling / digging of trenches, watering of garden, washing of utensils / clothes, filling & carrying of water, handling of office equipment. Additionally, an individual would also be tasked to perform jobs associated with hair cutting, shaving, head massage, ironing clothes, stitching of leather items / sole making, repair of leather items, shoe polishing, cutting/ stitching / alteration / darning of garments and making ribbons, badges etc.

#### PROCEDURE TO APPLY

9. Candidates are required to download blank application form and other certificates hosted in sub tab "Application Forms", under "Agniveervayu Non-Combatants" tab hosted on web portal <a href="https://agnipathvayu.cdac.in">https://agnipathvayu.cdac.in</a>. Duly filled application form and other certificates may be submitted by normal post / drop box to / at any one of the locations indicated below, so as to reach on or before due date given in employment news notification. Applications not as per format hosted on above said web portal will be rejected. Applications received after due date will not be accepted. Candidature of candidates submitting multiple applications will be rejected in total. Incomplete applications, in terms of information / documents, will be rejected. - 10. Candidates are required to attach following documents with the application. Applications received without documents are liable to be rejected: -
  - (a) Class 10<sup>th</sup> / Matriculation Mark Sheet & Passing Certificate.
  - (b) Passport size recent colour photograph (Not older than six months as on the last date of receipt of application) (front portrait in light background without head gear

- except for Sikhs). The photograph is to be taken with candidate holding a black slate in front of his chest with his name and date of photograph taken, clearly written on it with white chalk in capital letters. Two copies of the same photograph should be retained by the candidate for submitting at the time of enrolment.
- (c) Consent certificate by Parents / Legal guardian is required for the candidate below 18 years of age. Consent certificate is to be signed by candidate himself if he is above 18 years of age.

# **TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

- 11. **Agniveervayu Non-Combatant** will be enrolled in the Indian Air Force under Air Force Act 1950, for a period of **four years**. **Agniveervayu Non-Combatant** would form a distinct rank in the Indian Air Force, different from any other existing ranks. Indian Air Force is not obliged to retain Agniveervayu Non-Combatant beyond the engagement period of four years.
- 12. On completion of four years of service, based on organisation's requirements and policies promulgated by the Indian Air Force, Agniveervayu Non-Combatant will be offered an opportunity to apply for permanent enrolment in the Indian Air Force as NC (E). These applications will be considered in a centralised manner based on objective criteria including performance during their four year engagement period and up to 25% of each specific batch of Agniveervayu Non-Combatant will be enrolled in regular cadre of IAF. Agniveervayu Non-Combatant will not have any right to be selected for further enrolment into the Indian Air Force. Selection of the Agniveervayu Non-Combatant for further enrolment, if any, shall be at the discretion of the *IAF*.
- 13. **Employability**. Agniveervayu Non-Combatant enrolled under this entry are liable to be assigned specific duty in organisational interest, at the discretion of the Indian Air Force. He will be deployed on the jobs related to Hospitality or Housekeeping Streams.
- 14. <u>Training</u>. On being enrolled, Agniveervayu Non-Combatant will be imparted specific job training as per allotted stream based on Indian Air Force requirement.
- 15. <u>Leave</u>. Grant of leave will be subject to exigencies of Indian Air Force. The following leave may be applicable for Agniveervayu Non-Combatants during their engagement period:-
  - (a) Annual Leave. 30 days per year.
  - (b) **Sick Leave**. Based on medical advice.
- 16. <u>Pay, Allowances and Allied Benefits</u>. Agniveervayu Non-Combatant enrolled under this Scheme will be paid an Agniveer package of Rs. 30,000/- per month with a fixed yearly increment. In addition, Risk and Hardship allowances (as applicable in IAF), Dress and Travel allowances will be paid. Perks such as ration, clothing, accommodation and Leave Travel Concession (LTC) shall also be provided as per the existing rules.
- 17. <u>Terminal Benefits Seva Nidhi Package</u>. Agniveervayu Non-Combatants will be given one time 'Seva Nidhi' package comprising their monthly contribution along with

matching contribution by the Government on completion of their engagement period, as indicated below:-

**Note 1:** Agniveervayu Non-Combatant will not be required to contribute to any Provident Fund of the Government.

**Note 2:** There shall be no entitlement to gratuity and any kind of pensionary benefits.

- 18. <u>Medical and CSD Facilities</u>. For the duration of their engagement period in Indian Air Force, Agniveervayu Non-Combatant will be entitled for medical facility at Service Hospitals as well as CSD provisions.
- 19. <u>Insurance, Death and Disability Compensation</u>. Agniveervayu Non-Combatant will be provided non-contributory Life Insurance cover of Rs. 48 Lakhs for the duration of their engagement period as Agniveervayu Non-Combatant in the Indian Air Force. Agniveervayu Non-Combatant will not be governed by provisions contained in the Pension Regulations / Rules for Indian Air Force.
- 20. <u>Agniveer Skill Certificate</u>. At the end of engagement period, a detailed Skill-Set certificate will be provided to the Agniveervayu Non-Combatant, highlighting the skills and level of competency acquired by *them* during their engagement period.
- 21. Personnel enrolled under this Scheme will not be eligible for Ex-Servicemen status.

### **SEQUENCE OF EXAMINATION**

22. Candidates whose applications have been accepted will be issued with Admit Cards for written test. The admit cards will have the date, location and time of written test. Candidates are expected to report for written test at appointed time and adhere to the instructions contained in Admit Card. Candidates reporting for the written test are required to carry following documents for verification at examination Centre: -

- (a) The candidates should carry his AADHAAR Card (as displayed on their Admit Card) as proof of identity whenever they report for the Selection Test. Candidates from J&K, Assam and Meghalaya are to carry any other valid ID Proof.
- (b) Character certificate signed by Gazetted Officer / Panchayat Officer / Principal of school (if studied during last 01 year only) / Principal of College (if studying/studied during last 01 year), **not older than 6 month** and must have the office seal of the issuing officer.
- (c) Original 10<sup>th</sup> / Matriculation Passing Certificate (required for verification of candidate's name, father's name and his date of birth).
- (d) Original 10<sup>th</sup> / Matriculation Marks Sheet.
- (e) Experience certificate, if any.

<u>Note 1</u>: The original passing certificates / marks sheets shall not be retained by the examination Centre. The same shall be returned to the candidates on completion of detailed verification.

**Note-2**: Internet copy of mark-sheet not acceptable.

## Phase - I (Written Test)

23. The written test will be conducted at the IAF Station / location where the candidate has submitted his application. Written test will be common for both streams. A *min aggregate* score of 10 is required for a candidate to pass written examination. The subject wise breakdown of written test are as follows: -

- 24. <u>Debarring of Candidates Permanently for Selection Tests of Agniveervayu</u>

  <u>Non-Combatant</u>. Candidate shall be debarred permanently from appearing in Selection

  Tests of Agniveervayu Non-Combatant, if he is involved in any of the following type of incidents: -
  - (a) Using unfair means in exam hall such as copying from written material on any paper or body parts etc.

- (b) Carrying or in possession of prohibited items in the exam venue such as Bluetooth device, digital device, wireless device, microphone, spy cameras, or any other electronic gadgets etc.
- (c) Carrying or in possession of chits / slips in the exam venue or involvement in impersonation cases.
- (d) Taking snapshot or making video of question papers, other exam related materials or carrying or in possession of mobile phone beyond frisking zone. Carrying away of exam material such as answer sheets.
- (e) Threatening / misbehaving with BOO Members / IOS / support staff etc.
- (f) Appearing with forged Admit card, identity proof or any other malpractice or impersonation cases.
- 25. <u>Action Against Candidate Found Indulging in Unfair Means</u>. If any candidate resorts to unfair means during selection test, he will be withdrawn from the examination and his candidature will be cancelled after obtaining his signature on an undertaking to the effect

## Phase - II (Physical Fitness Test)

- 26. Only candidates who have passed written test will be permitted to appear in Physical Fitness Test. Depending on the number of candidates passing written test, a decision may be taken to permit either all candidates to appear for PFT or restrict it to a ratio, in the order of written test merit. To the extent possible, Physical Fitness Test will be conducted on same day of the written test. However, candidates should be prepared to stay at own expenses if the test cannot be conducted on the same day, in which case it will be conducted on next day. PFT will be common and **qualifying** in nature for both streams. Candidates will have to submit '**Consent Certificate**' signed by legal guardian or self before commencement of Physical Fitness Test. The candidates will be subjected to tests as explained in succeeding paragraphs.
- 27. <u>Height Check.</u> Candidates shall be checked for min acceptable height of **152 Cms**. Candidates below stipulated height requirement will be disqualified and not to be taken for any further tests.
- 28. <u>Physical Fitness Test 1 (PFT-1)</u>. Only candidates qualifying height check will be permitted to appear in PFT -1, which would be a **1.6 Km run** to be completed within 6.30 minutes (**six minutes thirty seconds**). If the PFT is conducted in High Altitude areas, the above timing will be suitably modified as per the following: -

(a) Upto 5000 feet : Nil

(b) 5001 to 9000 feet : Additional 30 Seconds

- (c) 9001 to 12000 feet: Additional 120 seconds
- 29. <u>Physical Fitness Test 2 (PFT-2)</u>. Only candidates qualifying in PFT -1 will be permitted to appear in PFT-2. Candidates may familiarize themselves with test procedure by watching demo videos for PFT-2 uploaded under Non-Combatants tab of web portal <a href="https://agnipathvayu.cdac.in">https://agnipathvayu.cdac.in</a>. In order to qualify in PFT-2, candidates should complete 10 push-ups, 10 sit-ups and 20 squats within stipulated time as per the following: -

#### Phase - III (Stream Suitability Test)

- 30. The Stream Suitability Test (SST) shall be **qualifying in nature** and a certain ratio of candidates, in order of merit, who have passed written test and PFT may be administered this test. Candidate Should be willing to undergo training and perform any tasks in the stream and **score a min of 50% aggregate (15 marks)** to qualify in SST. **Unwillingness** to perform any specific tasks associated with the stream will lead to **disqualification** of the candidate in SST. Performance of candidates will be assessed as per following template to assess qualification in the test: -
  - (a) Unwillingness to perform any of the tasks in the stream will lead to disqualification of the candidate in SST.

### (b) Hospitality.

- (i) Demonstrated aptitude for tasks associated with cooking including cutting of meat / vegetable / fish, handling of kitchen equipment, Preparation of dishes, and presentation of food.
- (ii) Knowledge of sanitation and hygiene requirements of kitchen / dining hall and Inclination/attitude to maintain same.
- (iii) Demonstrated aptitude to serve food / water / beverages.
- (iv) Personal hygiene and appearance.
- (v) Common knowledge of cooking appliances and kitchen fire/safety precautions.

#### (c) Housekeeping.

- (i) Demonstrated ability to sweep floors / roads, clean bathrooms / commodes / urinals.
- (ii) Demonstrated ability to cut grass, water garden and dig trenches.
- (iii) Demonstrated ability to wash utensils.
- (iv) Demonstrated performance in any one of the following: -

Washing and ironing of clothes.

or

Hair cutting/dressing / shampooing with required hand & eye coordination.

or

Stitching of leather items/proficiency as mochi.

or

Tailoring/knowledge of fabrics/design and pattern-cutting skills.

## Phase -IV (Medical Examination)

- 31. <u>Medical Examination</u>. A certain number of candidates as per merit who have qualified in stream Suitability test will be medically examined at designated place. Medical examination shall be conducted by Air Force Medical Team as per IAF medical standards and policy in vogue on subject issue. Medical examination would also include baseline Investigation of: -
  - (a) Blood Haemogram Hb, TLC, DLC, Platelets
  - (b) Urine RE/ME
  - (c) Biochemistry
    - (i) Blood Sugar Fasting & Post Prandial
    - (ii) Serum Cholesterol
    - (iii) RFT- Serum Urea, Uric acid, Creatinine
    - (iv) LFT- Serum Bilurubin, SGOT, SGPT
  - (d) Radiograph chest (PA view)
  - (e) ECG (R)
  - (f) Any other investigation deemed necessary by the Recruiting Medical Officer.
- 32. The recruitment medical officer and the specialist doctors of Armed Forces are the final authorities on declaring a candidate fit or unfit during initial medical examination and medical examination prior to enrolment. The candidates shall be governed by Armed Forces standards which may be at variance from civil standards. There is no provision for representation or review after the declaration of unfit by medical authority.

<u>Note.</u> Candidates are advised to get tartar and stains removed from their teeth before appearing for the Medical Examination. Ears should be free of wax. Candidates should be prepared to stay for the medical test for four to five days under their own arrangement. No TA/DA shall be admissible. Candidates using corrective glasses must be in possession of prescription from ophthalmologist bearing stamp and registration number and it should not be more than one month old. Passing in the medical examination is not a guarantee for employment in Indian Air Force.

- 33. General instructions. General instructions for candidates are as follows: -
  - (a) Candidates not reporting for the written test at or before cutoff time will not be permitted to appear in the same.
  - (b) Candidates should be prepared to stay for the entire duration of the tests under their own arrangement. No TA/DA shall be admissible.
  - (c) Mobile phones / smart watches / electronic gadgets shall not be permitted in the examination hall.
- 34. COVID-19 Instructions for Candidates appearing for Selection Test.
  - (a) Given the risk of COVID-19, candidates are advised to follow all instructions / guidelines issued by Central / State Governments from time to time.
  - (b) At the entrance any candidate showing symptoms of Influenza Like Illness (ILI), will not be allowed for the test considering the safety of other persons.
